The EU Natura 2000 Network

- > 27 000 sites
- > 1 000 000 km²
- > 18 % EU land
- ~4 % EU seas





Key protection principles of Natura 2000

- Conserves around 1000 species & 200 habitat types across entire natural range in the EU, irrespective of political boundaries
- Selects sites using the same scientific criteria; EU PA coverage tripled
- Offers strong legal protection but has high flexibility and subsidiarity provisions
- Not all strictly protected areas supports sustainable development: new activities or development affecting N2000 are not automatically excluded
- Works in collaboration with land owners & users;









Natura 2000 is at the core of the EU Green Infrastructure

- ✓ A strategically planned and delivered network of natural and semi-natural areas with other environmental features designed and managed to deliver a wide range of ecosystem services.
- Provides ecological and functional connectivity
- ✓ Aimed to enhancing Europe's Natural Capital
