




## Spatial Direction Territorial Andes Nororientales (DTAN), National Parks of Colombia






- 8 protected areas



14,254,144.29 hectares




Illicit crops: 3.701 hectares in the 18 areas







# Road farm sanitation: Typologies found in property taxes DTAN












Pioneering model in the country and region

## Conclusions

Consolidate UOT (its acronym in Spanish) policy is worth approximately: US \$ 1,250 million over 10 years required for consolidation

Informality in land tenure

Lack of a legal framework to address the problem

Prioritization in state decisions - greater institutional coordination

Socio-economic conflicts are rooted in the unequal land tenure

DTAN Regional- management model nationally
