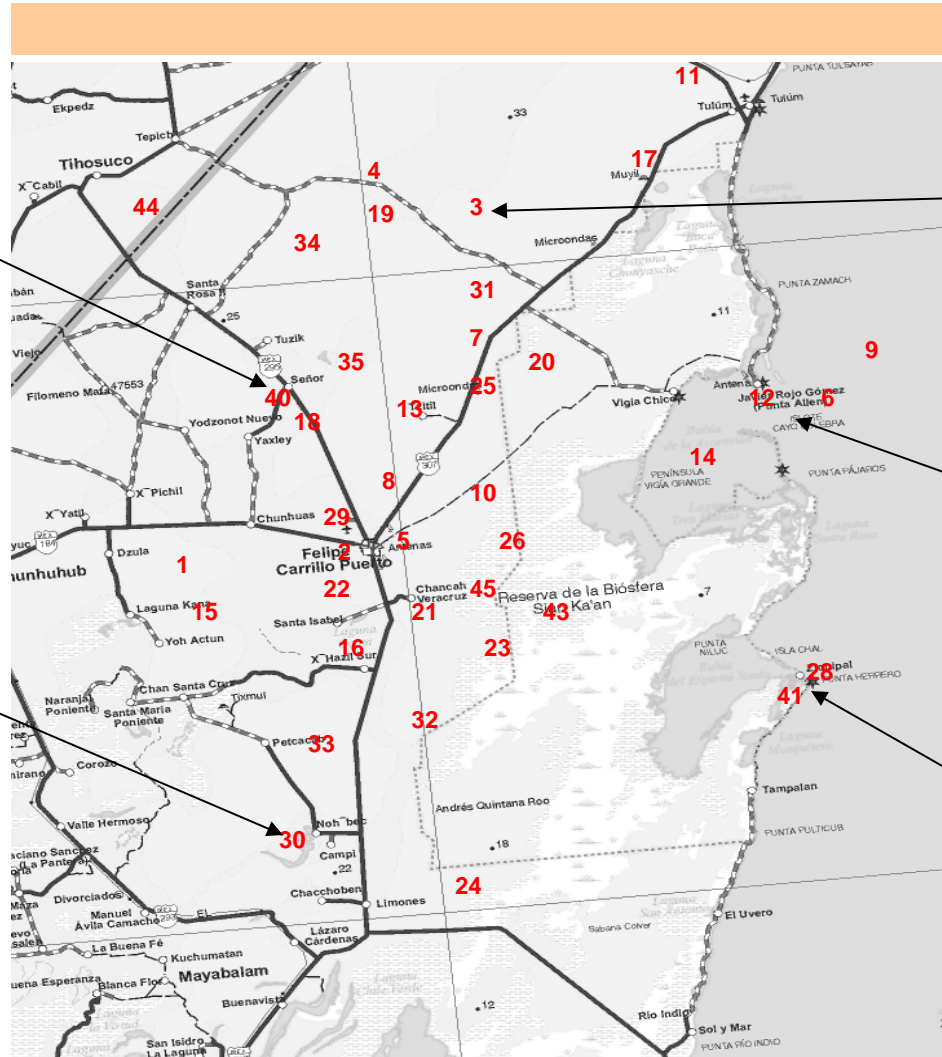


Sustainable use of biodiversity



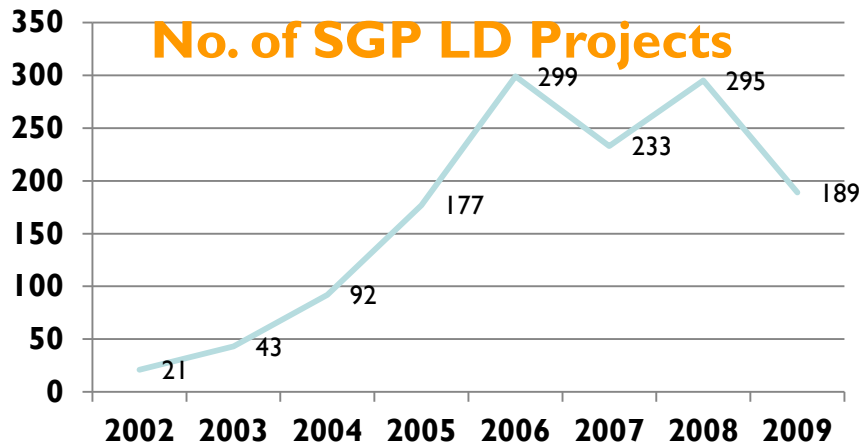

New SGP Strategic Initiatives

Dedicated IP Funding Mechanism

- *Basically not because there is a large initial fund involved but rather that special approaches and procedures will be developed with IPs*
- *Major work to be initiated to resource mobilize*



SGP and Women Empowerment

- Projects should proactively seek gender equality and women empowerment
- Monitoring and evaluation of gender equality outcomes
- Establishment of “SGP Women Grantees Network”



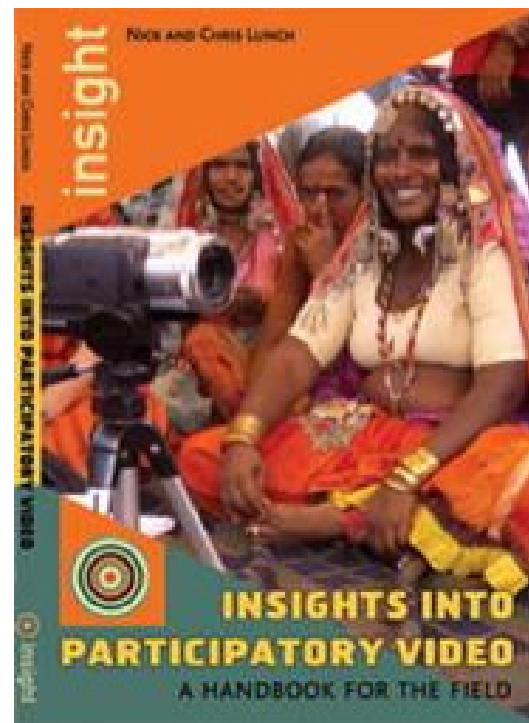
Capacity and institutional development

- Capacity building as a cross-cutting objective (*for CSOs with priority for CBOs and IPs*)
- Knowledge and Best Practice Fairs
- Digital Library of Community Innovations
- South-South Community Innovation Exchange Platform
- CSO-Government Dialogue Platforms



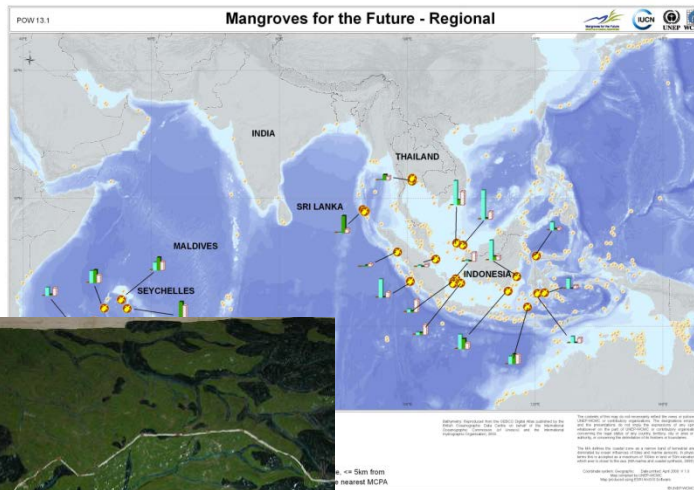
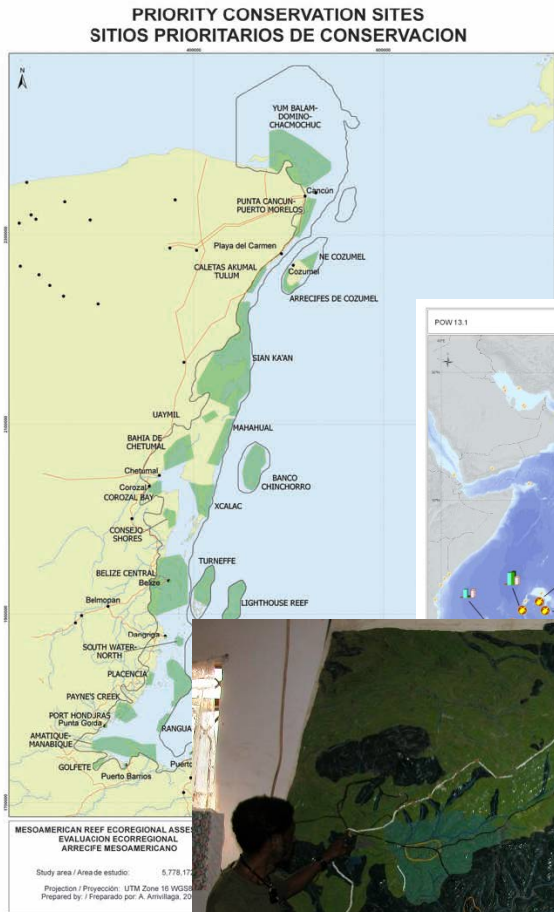
Flexible, Fast, Friendly Processes

- Set up flexible, **time sensitive**, and simple project cycle to allow “difficult to reach” groups
- Pioneer user-friendly modalities
- Option to submit in local or vernacular languages
- Strategic use of **planning grants**
- Allowance for flexible disbursement terms (i.e. grants direct to communities)



Participatory mapping models & techniques

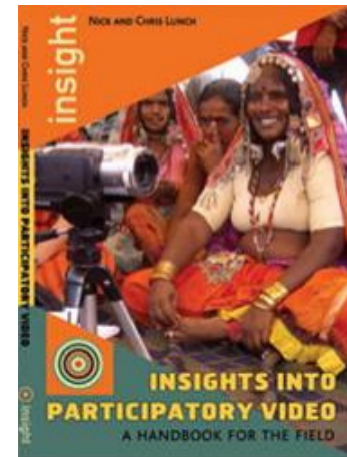
Support to innovative mapping techniques for ICCAs, adaptation and resilience (P3DM, cyber-tracker etc.)

- Allow for expression in local and *vernacular languages*

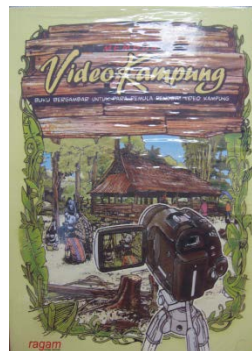
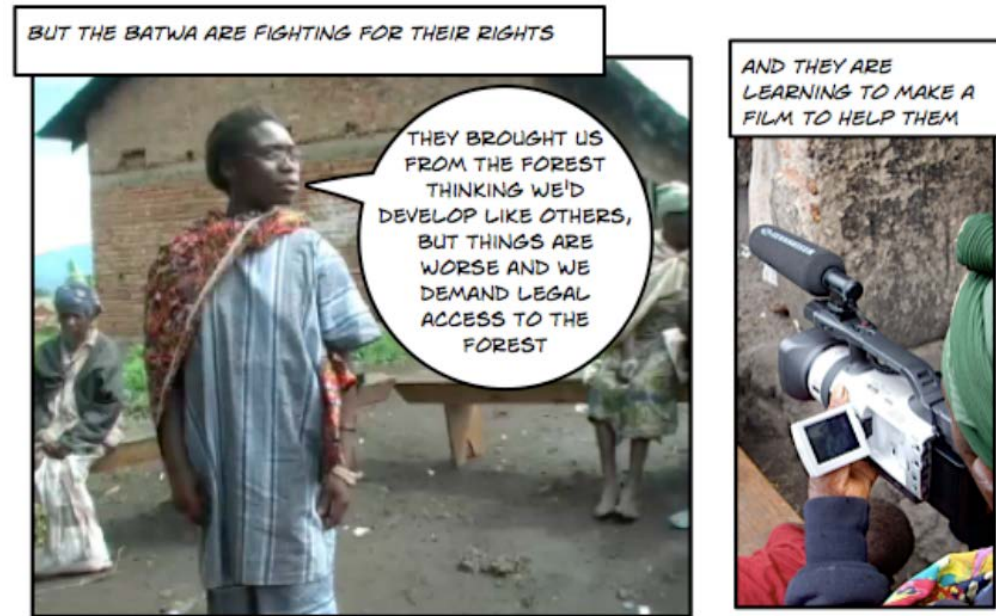

Participatory Video (PV) methodology

- Numerous **PV trainings** held in Cameroon, Samoa, Indonesia, Kazakhstan
- Indigenous **PV films disseminated** IUCN WCC, COP15
- Handbook(s) in **7 languages**
- DotSub partnership to enable **subtitling** into 400+ languages



Challenges

- *How to be truly demand-driven? (IPs meaningfully engaged in decision-making)*
- *How to get representatives on behalf of many diverse IP communities and groups?*
- *How to adapt the procedures and requirements to fit IP “cosmo-vision” and practices?*
- *How to prioritize? (identification of “hotspots” in area and issue a feasible idea?)*
- *How to mainstream and scale up? (designing IP appropriate components in major global initiatives such as CBR+ for REDD+, IP components in GEF FSPs)*
